

**Studio Description** 

As an extension of the 2020 Overlook Seminar - EXPERIMENT, this summer studio will develop a proposal for a Landscape Laboratory on the North Campus Riverfront. The landscape lab will be an extension of the Fuller Center and bring the award-winning model of the Overlook Field School to campus. With this space, students will be able to design, test, and install landscape installations at the lab and monitor their performance over time.
