

# PORTLAND PROGRAM CHECKLIST

Portland provides a unique opportunity for the study of urban architecture. Students must be in good academic standing and have completed the requirements listed below prior to changing campus locations.

Curriculum issues that need to be addressed prior to going to Portland:

- (1) You are encouraged to complete your ARH series before heading to Portland, but architecture history courses are available in Urban Design and Historic Preservation.
- (2) Intermediate and terminal studios (in-person), ARCH 4/571 (fall, hybrid format), and ARCH 4/517 (winter, hybrid format) are offered every year. The Structures and ECS sequences are offered every other year in Portland.  
 Structures sequence - offered in the beginning of fall term of *odd years in a SYNC WEB, hy-flex format*  
 ECS sequence - offered in the beginning fall term of *even years in a SYNC WEB, hy-flex format*
- (3) The advanced building technology course requirement can be taken in Portland and is usually offered twice per academic year
- (4) Subject Area Elective courses, including those that may fulfill the departmental architectural history requirements, are offered on a varying schedule.
- (5) **Limited instructional GE positions are available in PDX. Typically there are 2-3 for the academic year that may involve a combination of in-person and virtual instruction. Research GE positions can become available through the labs on campus.**
