AutoCAD is the industry standard for technical drawing in many offices. Competency in CAD software is critical for most entry level designers and communication with consultants in engineering, architecture, planning and the arts. Proficiency in CAD also aids in learning programs such as Rhino, Solidworks, and Revit which are common in landscape practice.

Landscape Media III will focus on developing a working competency in AutoCAD in support of design studios as well as professional practice.

Class meets twice weekly for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Classes will typically be structured with in-class demonstrations, exercises and project worktime.
